POPULATION UNDER 18 (DECENNIAL CENSUS)

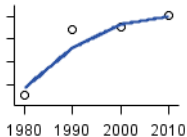

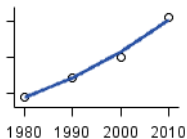

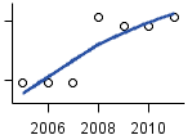

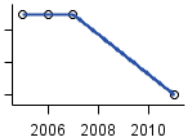
NUMBER OF HOSPITAL BEDS

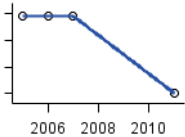

ADULT CARE HOMES: NUMBER OF BEDS



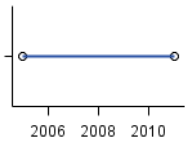

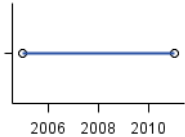

NUMBER OF ASSISTED LIVING BEDS

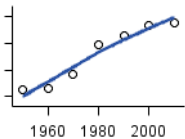

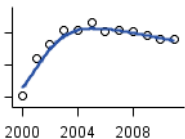

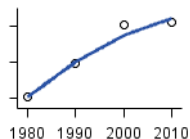

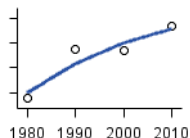

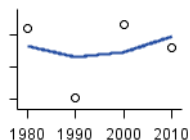
RENTER OCCUPIED HOUSING UNITS

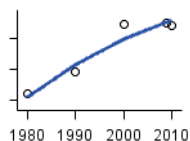

MEDIAN VALUE (\$): OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING UNITS



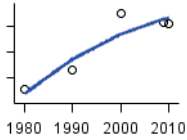

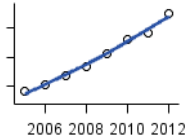

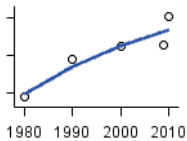
FAIR MARKET RENT: 2 BEDROOMS

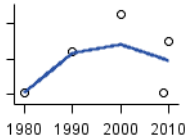

POPULATION AGE 25+



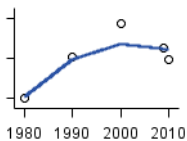

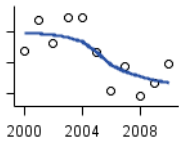
PERCENT BACHELORS DEGREE OR HIGHER AGE 25+

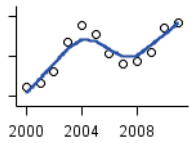

ESTIMATED NUMBER OF PEOPLE IN POVERTY

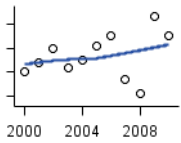

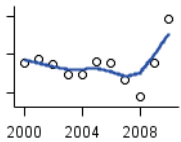

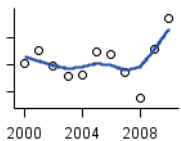

EST. % OF RELATED CHILDREN AGE 5 TO 17 IN FAMILIES IN POVERTY

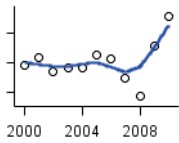

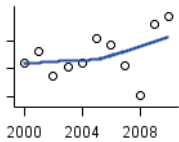

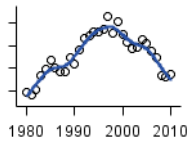


ESTIMATED PERCENT UNDER 18 IN POVERTY

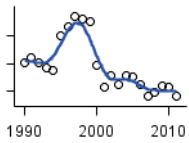
CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE (BLS-Place

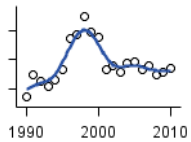

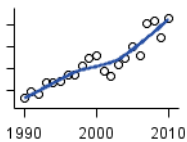

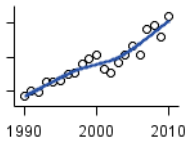
BEA PER CAPITA PERSONAL INCOME (\$)

BANK DEPOSITS (1984-2004 in thousands; 2005- in millions)



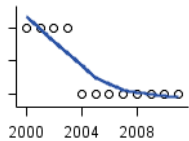

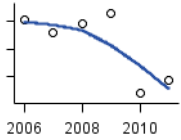

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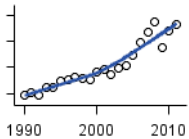

SALES TAX COLLECTIONS (\$)

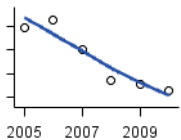

CRIME INDEX OFFENSES



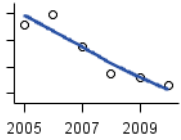

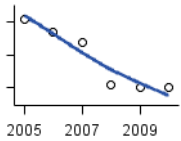
PROPERTY CRIMES

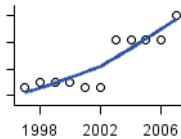

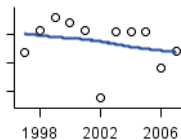
NUMBER OF FARMS

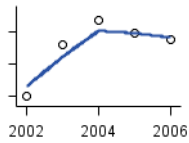
TOTAL ACRES HARVESTED



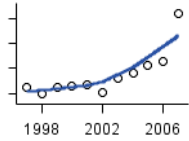
